You should note that the Staff Search and Web OPAC sessions are on the web page. These were not completed in time to make it to the CD's. However, it is important that everyone look at the Staff Search session, as it is common to all modules.





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The ALEPH Blueprint

Description: This training program is delivered via a CD that is loaded on individual workstations and is comprised of pre-recorded sessions via a commercial product called *Interwise*. Individual workstations need to be equipped with speakers or headphones, as well as a microphone for live Q&A sessions. These sessions provide the participants with the basics of each module:

Circulation

- Create a new patron
- Basic loan and return operations
- Basic hold operations
- Basic cash operations
- Introduction to submitting report jobs & following up on them

Cataloging

- Basic copy cataloging
- Holdings record cataloging
- Items creation

Serials

- Basic prediction using the Cataloging method
- Basic prediction using the Template method
- Opening predicted issues and checking them in

Web OPAC

- Search Methods (find/browse/boolean/truncation/proximity/adjacency/synonyms)
- Display formats
- Post-search operations (view/refine/send/ print/save)
- Patron empowerment functionality (view and update of Circ transactions/update of personal data/SDI profiles requests/personal interface preferences)

Course Reserves

- Basic course operations: create/modify/ duplicate/delete
- Basic document operations: transfer/catalog/ create items
- Introduction to pickup lists and other reports

Acquisitions

- Basic budget creation
- Basic vendor creation
- Basic order creation
- Basic order arriving
- Basic order invoicing
- Basic holdings record cataloging
- Basic invoice creation

Staff Search

- Recap of basic ALEPH jargon
- Search Methods (find / browse / boolean / truncation / proximity / adjacency / synonyms)
- Display formats
- Post-search operations (view / refine / send / print / save)
